### Terms and Conditions for entry to Photography Competition jgallery 2019

- 1) **Photo Hero 2019** is a photographic competition open to all photographers over the age of 18 as of 1<sup>st</sup> September 2019, except employees of *jgallerymoulton* and their families and relatives, and (except as set out below in this paragraph) anyone else connected with this competition.
- 2) Entries must be identified with place and date taken
- 3) Entries must have been taken within the 6months immediately prior to the closing date. Images that have won an award (including winner, runner-up, highly commended, commended) in a national or international competition or that have been entered in such a competition where the results are still pending, are not eligible for entry.
- 4) All entries must be submitted digitally (scans from film are acceptable) and must be uploaded via [www.jgallery.org.uk](http://www.jgallery.org.uk) No entries will be accepted by mail. No digital files will be returned, but all Low-resolution images, apart from those short-listed, will be destroyed after the close of the competition.
- 5) The competition open Jan 2019 and the closing date for entries is the March 28<sup>TH</sup> 2019 (at midnight BST between the 27<sup>th</sup>-28<sup>th</sup>) Results will be announced and shortlisted photographers will be notified as soon as possible after closing date.

6) There is 1 category for submissions

**Subject 'THINGS FLOW'** (portraits, objects, events, activities etc) all acceptable.

7) Number of submissions

A maximum total of 2 images per entrant may be submitted. There is an admin fee of £10.00 for up to 2 entries. (payable on line with submissions)

#### 8) **Initial entry**

Image files should be uploaded to the site as JPEGS (72dpi) when resizing your pictures, please make sure that you do not overwrite your original file. You must ensure that you upload your images the right way around No responsibility can be taken by the organisers for images that are submitted backwards or incorrectly orientated. Black & white images are eligible, as are images of panoramic format.

#### 9) **File naming protocol.**

Please name your digital files with photo2019, initial & image number. For example, if your name is *jane smith* and you are submitting 2 images, your numbers would run from

**photo2019js01.jpg**  
**photo2019js02.jpg.**

Please do not include capital letters, spaces or any other characters in your file names. All images will be cross-referenced, by the organisers, with a unique identifying number, so that the judging is completely anonymous and based on the image alone. When you upload your images, you will be asked for caption information. This will not be used for judging purposes but must include where and when the photograph/s were taken. Please make sure you have the permission of any individuals identifiable within the photo.

#### 10) File sizes.

a) Images from digital cameras or camera phones can be submitted to "Photo Hero2019" and must have been taken using a camera with a sufficiently high resolution to allow the image to be reproduced at A4 size or above (at 300 dpi). We recommend that you use a camera of 4 mega pixels or more<sup>3</sup>

#### **NB Please ensure that your camera is on its highest-quality setting.**

b) Images that have been scanned from transparencies or negatives are eligible. They will need to be converted to the acceptable format as in section 8

#### 11) Digital adjustments.

Digital adjustments, including High Dynamic Range (HDR) imaging techniques and the joining together of multiple frames, are allowed. However, the integrity of the subject must be maintained and the making of.

The organisers reserve the right to disqualify any image that they feel lacks authenticity due to over manipulation.

#### 12) Copies.

Please ensure that you keep copies of submitted images. The organisers will take all reasonable steps to ensure the safe storage and back-up of entries, but cannot be held responsible for exceptional circumstances including Acts of God.

#### 13) Judging.

All entries will be assessed by a pre-judging panel approved by head judges, \*\*\*\*\* A shortlist will be announced following the closing date of . All those shortlisted will be contacted by email/telephone,

The organisers cannot be held responsible for emails that do not arrive due to the entrant's email security settings or restrictions placed by their Internet service provider. The final winner/s will be announced at the jgallery and on the web site 2 weeks after closing date.

#### 14) Prizes.

The entrant, who creates the photograph deemed by the judges to be the single best image, will become the jgallery "Photo Hero 2019 " and will win a cash prize £100. Other prizes will be available subject to our sponsors. All finalists will receive a certificate of achievement and merit

#### **General**

The organisers reserve the right to change prizes to ones of comparable value if required by unforeseen circumstances. Any such changes will be posted on the competition website. Prizes are not transferable and no cash equivalent will be available for non-cash prizes.

#### 15) Copyright and permissions.

By submitting images to "Photo Hero 2019", each entrant confirms and warrants that:

- a) they are the sole author of each entry and that it is their original work;
- b) they own the copyright and any other intellectual property rights of each image;
- c) they have the permission of those pictured in the image (or, where the image shows any persons under 16, the consent of their parent/guardian) for the usage rights required by *jgallery* and will indemnify *jgallery* against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement;
- d) they have not licensed or disposed of any rights in the image that would conflict with uses to be made by *jgallery* .
- e) they have received any necessary permissions from the owner(s) of buildings included in submitted images for the usage rights required by *jgallery* and will indemnify *jgallery* against any claims made by any third parties in respect of such infringement.

16) By entering the competition, you grant *jgallery* and its sponsors and supporters a non-exclusive, Irrevocable licence to reproduce, enlarge, publish or exhibit, on any media, the images for any purpose **connected with the competition**. This may include, but is not limited to:

- a) display at any exhibitions;
- b) on a secure web browser for judging purposes;
- c) on the *jgallery* website and on the websites of sponsors and supporters;
- e) for use in press releases to be distributed to national, regional & specialist press giving information about or promoting the competition.

If an image is short-listed, the photographer will be asked to supply an extended caption for that image.

Entrants also agree that the organisers can sub-license images to the media for reproduction in connection with the competition.

17) Copyright of each image is retained by its respective photographer.

18) *jgallery* reserves the right to remove any entries from the competition that it feels may breach or contravene laws of public decency or may bring the photographer, the competition, Take a view or any of its sponsors into disrepute. Such entries will be deemed as void and any fees paid will not be refunded.

*jgallery* will remove any entries that appear to have been taken by a member of the public trespassing, as this is a criminal offence which may lead to prosecution. Such entries will be deemed as void

19) The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Should the entries fall below the standard required by the competition organisers and the judges, then the organisers reserve the right not to award prizes.

20) All images must be uploaded, via the *jgallery* website, following the on-screen instructions. Any Queries should be directed to [info@jgallery.org.uk](mailto:info@jgallery.org.uk)

#### 21 **Withdrawn images.**

By accepting the terms and conditions of the competition and subsequently submitting your images, you have entered into an agreement with *jgallery*. Once entered, images cannot be withdrawn unless the organisers are notified of a permissions problem, in which case the images will be withdrawn on request of the copyright holder (entrant)

22) The information given in these Terms and Conditions is correct, but *jgallery* reserve the right to change any of the above without prior notice. By entering the competition, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these Terms and Conditions. Any breach of these Terms by an entrant will void their entry. If a breach has occurred, but is discovered after the award of a prize, then the organisers may request the return of that prize.
